Values with Line

OBJECTIVE

Through the use of hatching, cross-hatching, stippling and other techniques you can create a wide range of values. A variety of values adds contrast and visual interest to a drawing or design, whether it is representational or abstract.

MATERIALS

- 9" x 12" sheet of paper
- pencil
- ink pen

GRADING

10 points (5 points for timely completion and following directions + 5 points for using a variety of values that add contrast and visual interest)

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Practice creating values with line using different techniques on the attached sheet of paper.
- 2) Create a 6" x 6" drawing in pencil—this may be representational (a still life or landscape, for example) or an abstract design (see examples below).
- 3) Use ink pen to create values using a single or various techniques on your drawing. Erase pencil lines after completing the ink drawing.
